

“What Do You Want Jesus to Do for You?”
Mark 10:46-52

Read Mark 9:46-52

Three Questions:

1. How badly do you want to be in Jesus’ presence? (vs. 50)

Coronavirus has forced us to recognize at least two things:

- a. Fragility of life
- b. Reality of our mortality

Matthew 7:24-27:

²⁴ “Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock.

²⁶ And everyone who hears these words of mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. ²⁷ And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell, and great was the fall of it.”

John 16:33, “I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart, I have overcome the world.”

2. What do you want Jesus to do for you? (vs. 51)

- a. Jesus calls you to acknowledge your real problem
- b. Jesus meets you at the point of actual need

3. What are you going to do with it when you get it? (vs. 52)

Luke 18:43, “Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus, praising God. When all the people saw it, they also praised God.”

Bartimaeus was transformed from a beggar sitting **beside** the road to a disciple following Jesus **on** the road.
